JOHNSBURG SANITARY DISTRICT MONTHLY COMMISSION MEETING JULY 11, 2024 5:00 P.M. Taycheedah Town Hall

Members present: President Franz Schmitz, Commissioner Jason Meyer. Excused: Commissioner Ken Schneider. Also present: Recording Secretary Brenda Schneider.

- 1. <u>Call to order</u>. President Schmitz called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.
- 2. <u>Approval of the minutes of the 6/11/2024 meeting</u>. Motion by Jason Meyer, second by Franz Schmitz, to approve the minutes of the June 11th monthly meeting as distributed. Motion carried (2-0).
- 3. <u>Discussion and possible action regarding operational issues</u>:
 - a. <u>Meter station</u>. Nothing to report at this time.
 - b. <u>Lift Stations</u>. The June pump runtime reports were reviewed. The radio was replaced at the Cty. Q lift station due to malfunction in January. The daily reports now identify the station as "SPARE"; however, the cumulative data is not appearing on the monthly reports. Brenda submitted a support ticket to Missions regarding the monthly report.
 - c. <u>Grinder pump stations</u>. Nothing to report at this time.
 - d. <u>Clearwater Inspections</u>. The televising project was completed on March 29th. Grease and slivers of concrete were discovered; however, no major leaks were found. There are a few small fractures. There is concern as to whether or not the two stations were drawn-down to inspect the condition of the inlet pipe. Per communication from Great Lakes TV Seal, lift station #1 was at a low level and additional televising is not necessary; however, lift station #2 may warrant additional televising. Great Lakes submitted a quote of \$970.00 to perform the additional work on station #2. Consideration of the quote was postponed to the next meeting.

A home at Mengel Road/Johnsburg Road constantly has water running across the basement floor. John Rickert will be asked to take a look at it.

e. <u>Other operational issues</u>. The repair expense of \$582.67 for the damage caused to a vent pipe on Johnsburg Road as a result of an auto accident that occurred on March 22nd, has been submitted to the driver's insurance company.

The cost to repair the manhole as a result of a hit and run accident on May 5, was \$2,397.20. This expense can be submitted to the District's insurance company; however, there is a \$1,000 deductible. Motion by Jason Meyer, second by Franz Schmitz, to submit a claim to Rural Insurance Company. Motion carried (2-0).

4. <u>Approval of District bills</u>. Motion by Franz Schmitz, second by Jason Meyer, to approve the bills (order #48-53), for a total of \$4,035.62, and to authorize the following:

• Transfer \$4,000.00 from the Operations/User Charge Account to the regular checking account. Motion carried (2-0).

- 5. <u>Schedule the next meeting</u>. The next monthly meeting of the Commission is tentatively scheduled for Thursday August 15th, at 5:00 p.m.
- 6. <u>Adjournment</u>. President Schmitz declared the meeting adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
